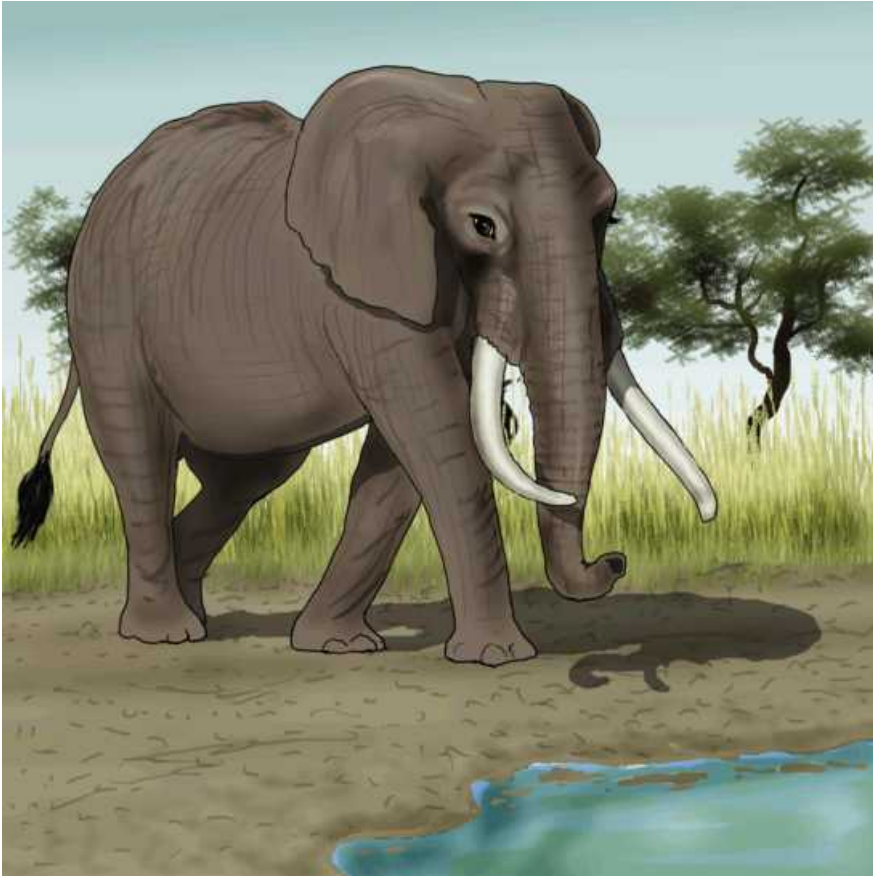

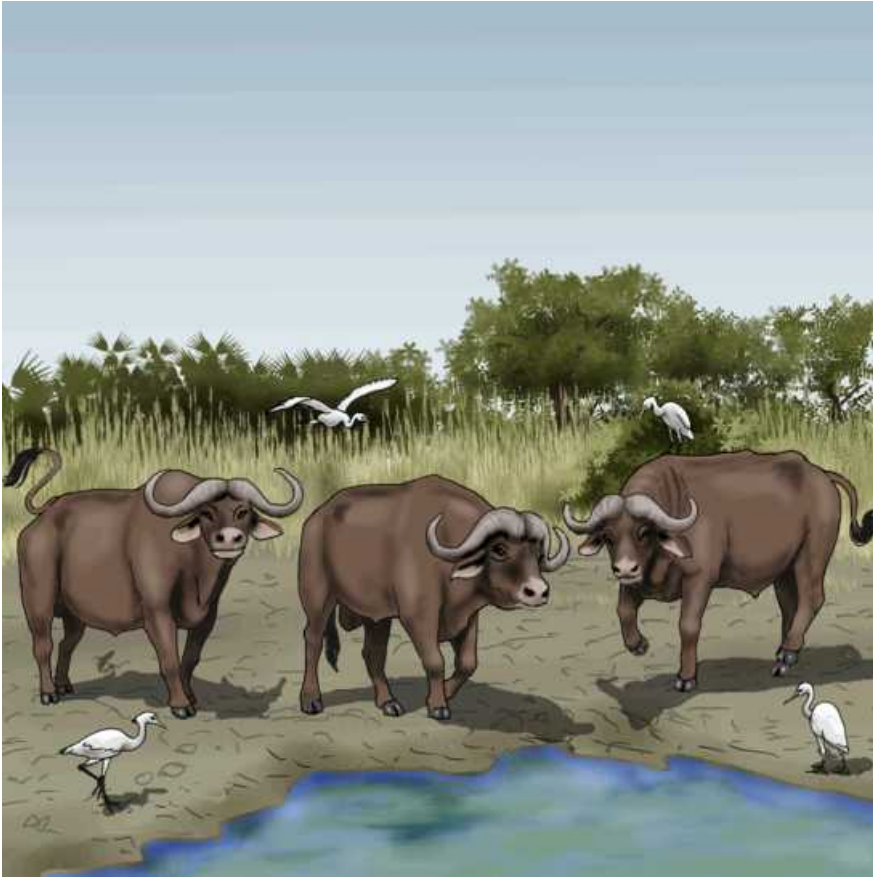

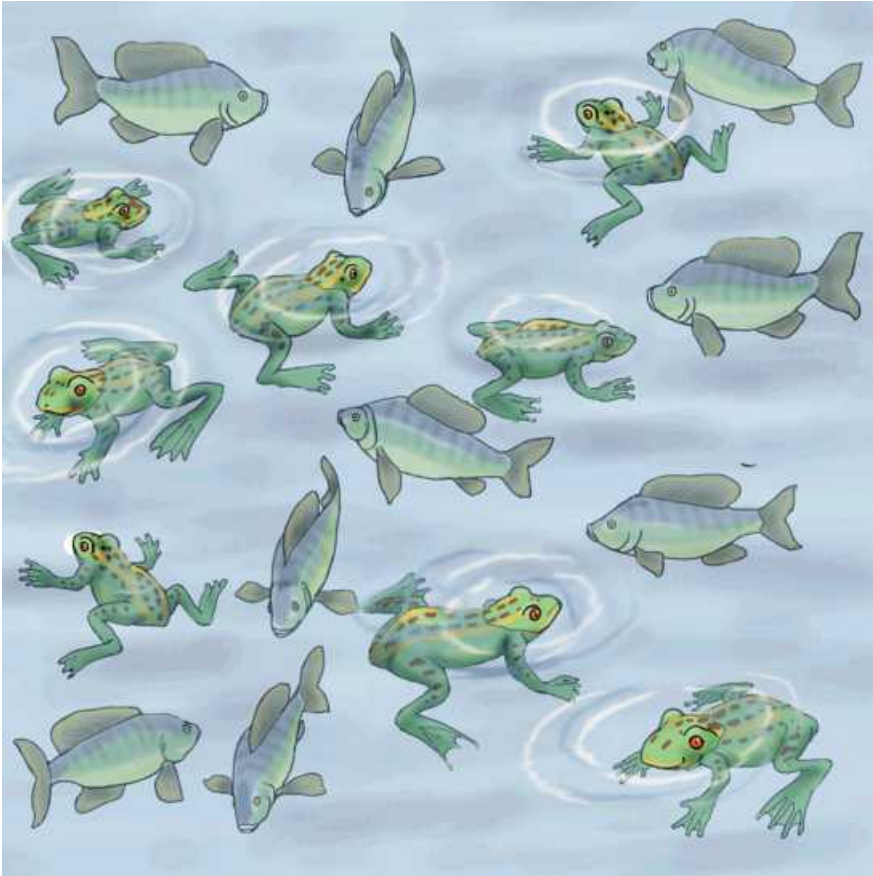
Five impalas and six
