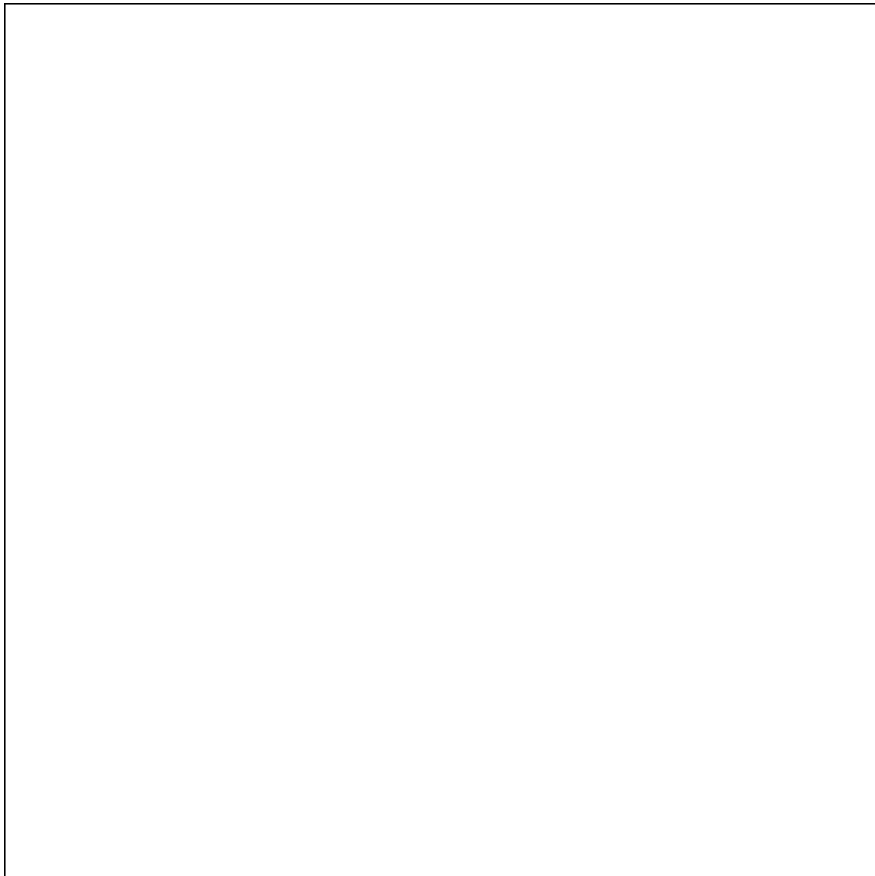
Tom carries a tray of ripe bananas.

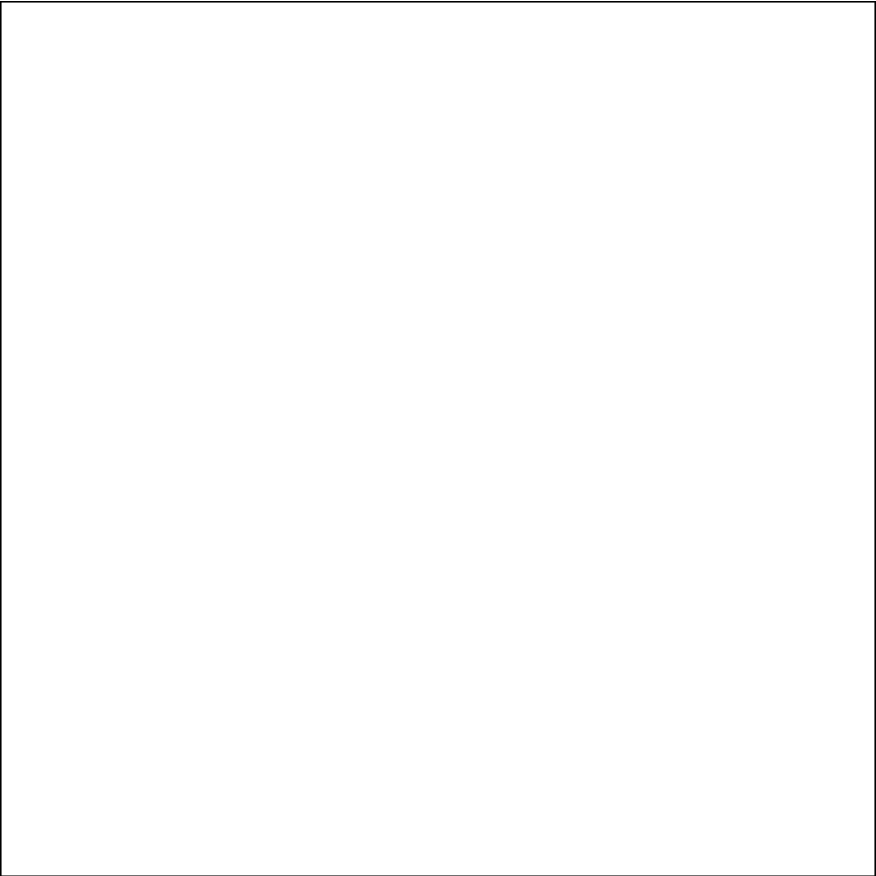
Tom goes to the market to sell

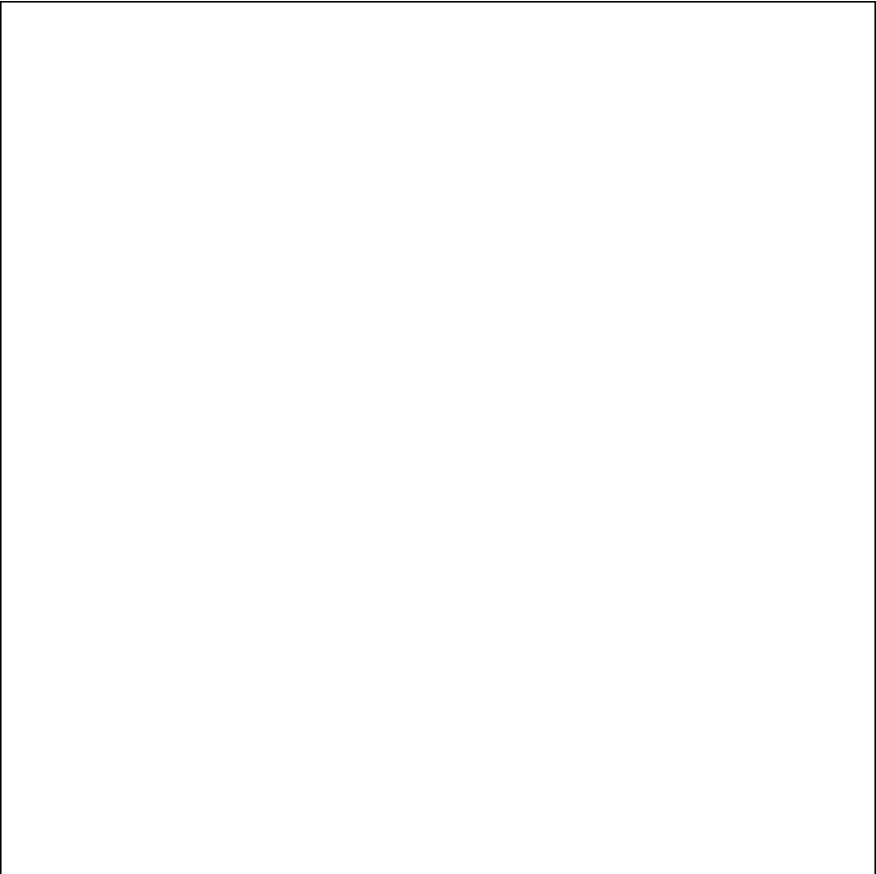
People at the market are buying

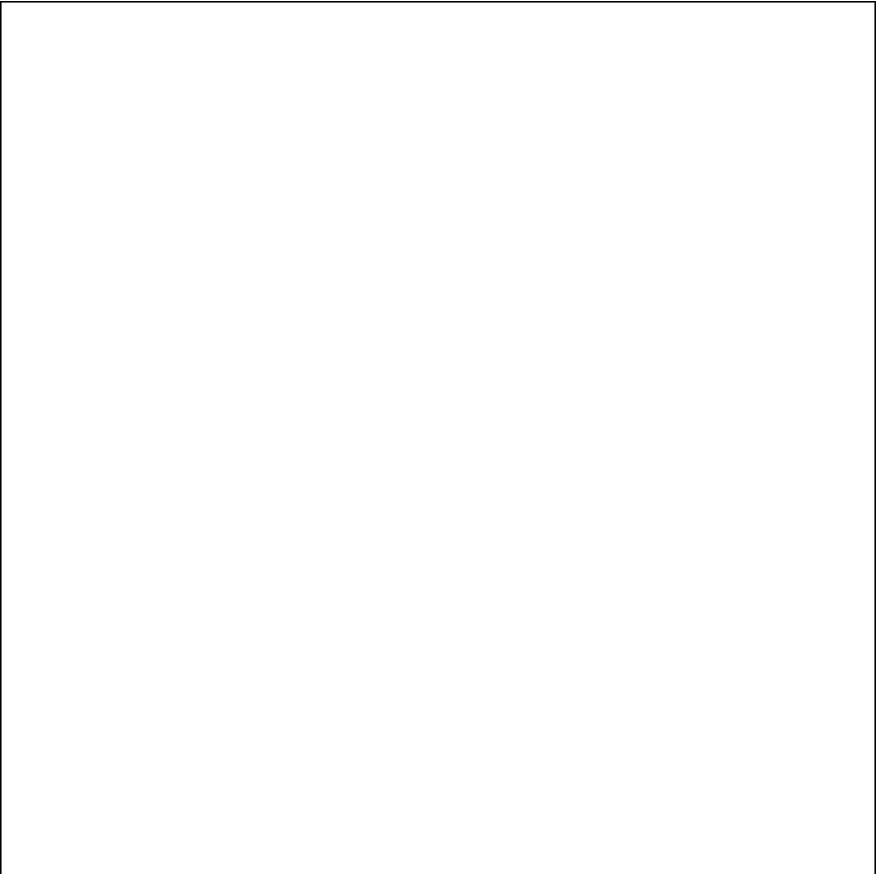
But no one is buying Tom's bananas. They prefer to buy fruit from women.

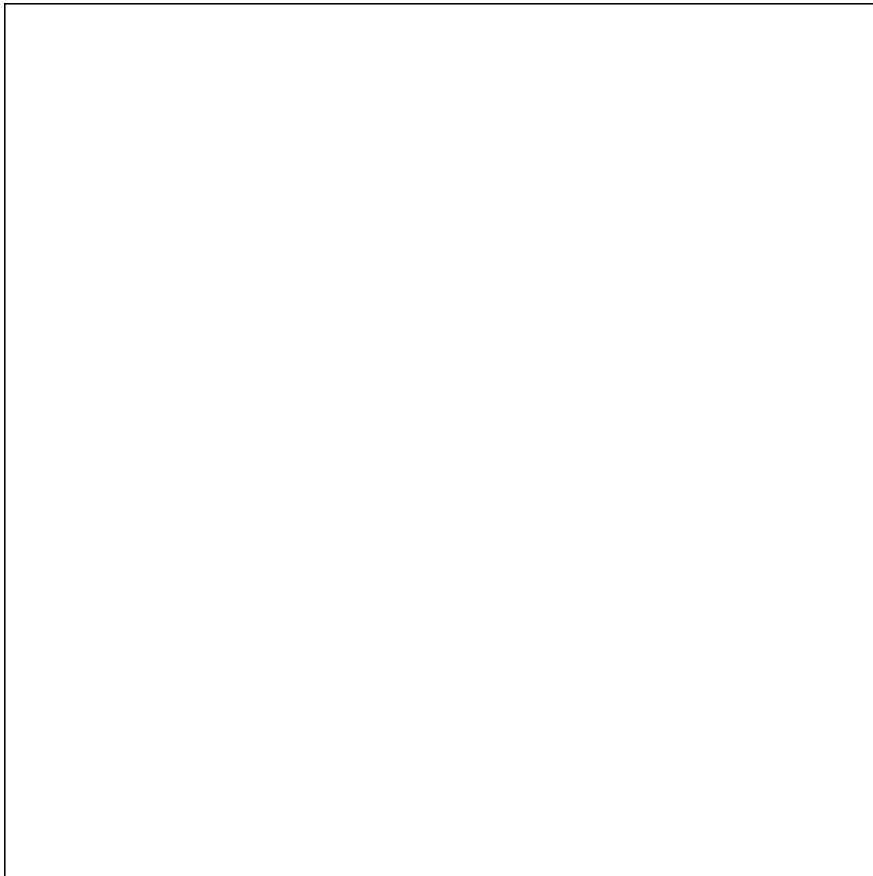
“In our community, only women sell fruit,” people say. “What kind of a man is this?” people ask.

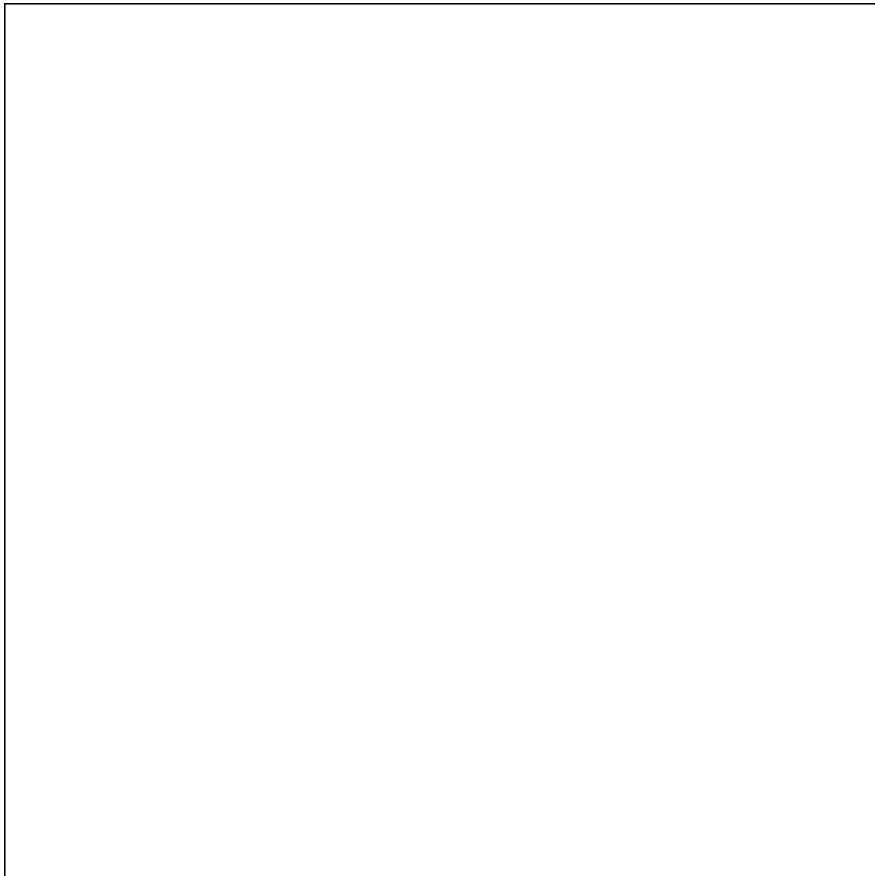
But Tom does not give up. He calls,

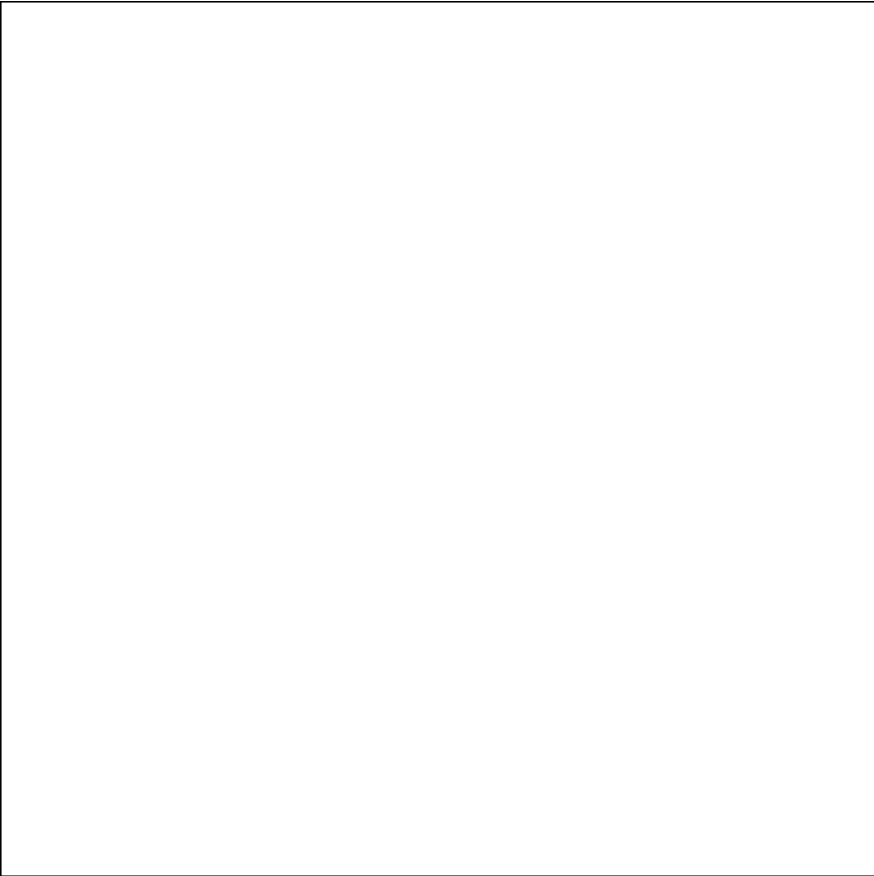
One woman picks up a bunch of


The woman buys the bananas.

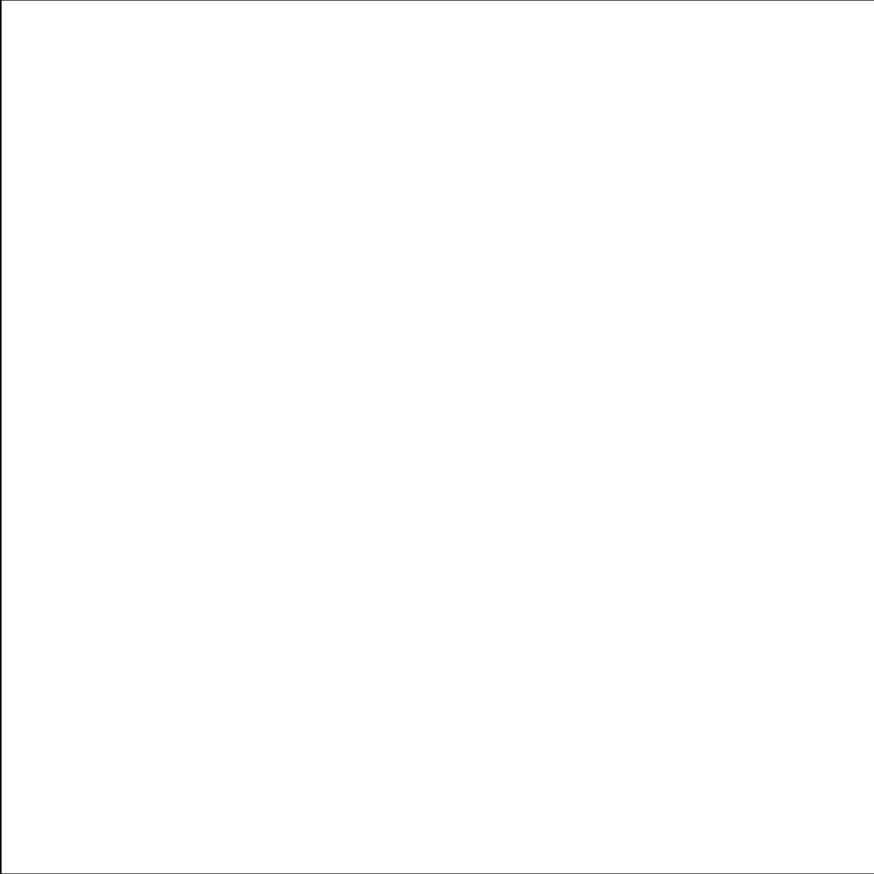
More people come to the stall.

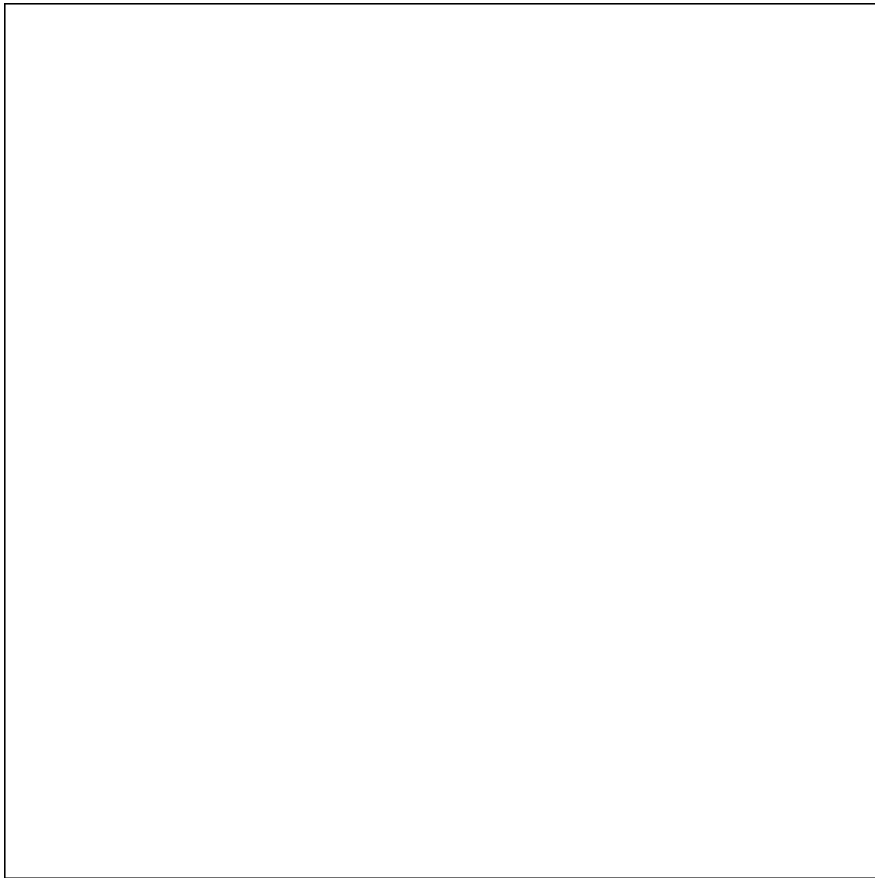
Soon, the tray is empty. Tom counts the money he earned.
