






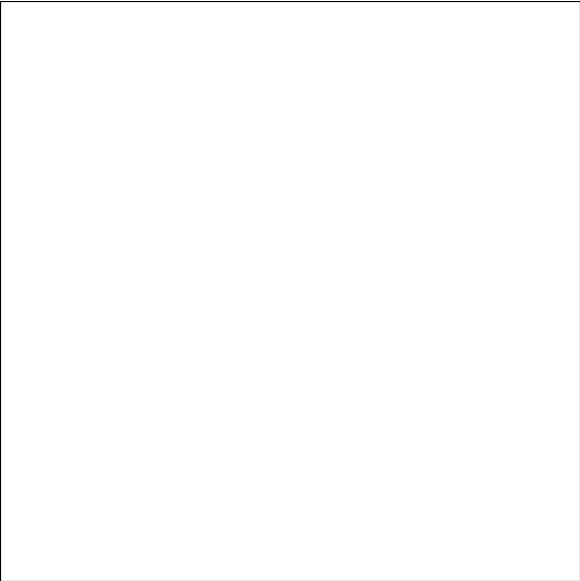
# 指蜜鸟的复仇
