





One elephant is going to
drink water.




Two giraffes are going to
drink water.




Three buffaloes and four birds are also going to drink water.



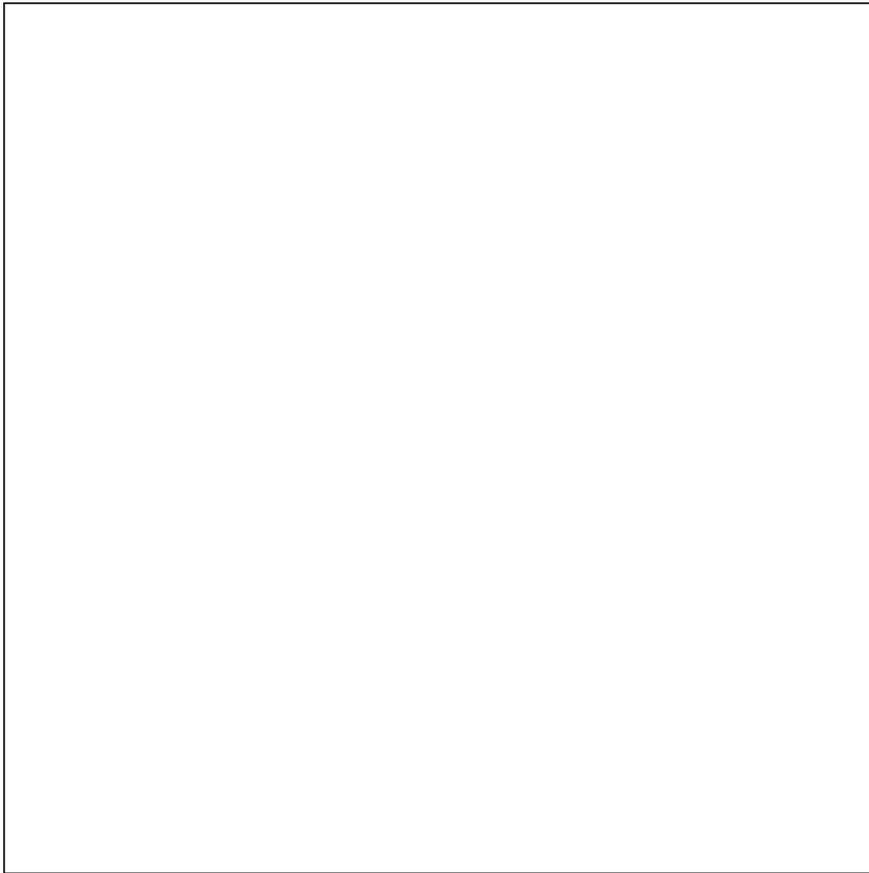
Five impalas and six warthogs are walking to the water.



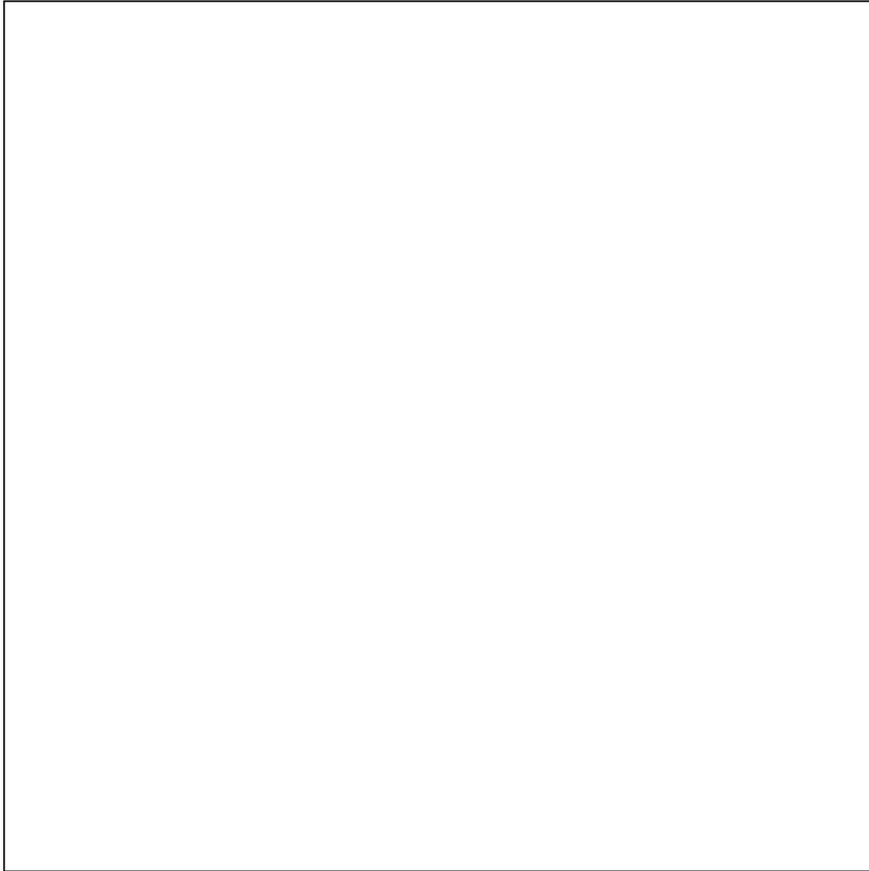
Seven zebras are running to the water.
